HOW TO WEAR & CARE FOR FACE MASKS



Wearing a face mask offers a layer of protection, but it's still important to maintain social distancing of at least six feet between others when you're out in public. Here are some tips for how to properly wear and care for a non-medical grade face mask or cloth face covering:

1

Make sure masks fit snugly but comfortably against the side of the face. Allow for breathing without restriction. Mask straps should be secure.

2

Avoid touching the mask, and use mask straps when removing. Wash hands before and after use.

3

After each use, cloth face coverings should be laundered and machine dried without damaging or changing the shape. Throw away disposable masks in trash after use.

Make sure face masks cover the nose and mouth.
